GENERAL GUIDELINES

- The theme of the event is "Brilliant Ideas Must Be Tagged".
- This is an offline competition and is open to students of classes VI onwards.
- A submission can be put forth by a team of: Minimum- 02 and Maximum- 04 members.
- The project can be an original pre-existing one or can be a fresh idea which the team would like to present.
- Only working projects/models are accepted.
- All presentations, if any, will be under the given template format.
- Last date for Registration will be Wednesday, 25
 October 2023. For Registration Link, "Click Here"

Perks of Participation

- The best project from each category will be rewarded with merit certificates, a trophy and a cash prize of ₹10,000/-.
- Second best project from each category will get merit certificates and a trophy.
- Third best project from each category will be rewarded with merit certificates
- The participants will gain an opportunity to interact with noted professionals in their fields.
- Participants will get a platform for innovating ways of engaging their audiences and peers in the advocacy and realization of the Goals.
- The shortlisted entries from each category will gain exposure in terms of promoting their projects and their contribution to societal development on our social media platforms and website.

There are 5 different categories for participation:

- Innovation (STEAM)
- Social welfare (Environment / Social issues)
- Entrepreneurship (Business ideas)
- Robotics Ground Zero
- Robotics Mud Race

Guidelines for Innovation, Social Welfare and Entrepreneurship:

- The theme of the event is "Brilliant Ideas Must be Tagged"
- The team must bring in a working project. Projects
 can be in the form of an APP, Website or a Physical
 project with or without the use of Robotics or AI.

There are two stages to the competition:

Stage 1 -

- Present your idea in the form of a proposal giving a brief description of your idea.
- It should be in a PDF format following the template provided. For template "Click Here"
- It should include the summary of the idea, its feasibility and reach out, and budget (if any).
- Teams are required to submit an AV that offers an overview of their project, providing concise insights into its concept, operations, and key details.
- All entries must be submitted through the link which will be sent after registration.
- The deadline for Registration and Proposal submission is Wednesday, 25 October 2023
- The deadline of the AV submission is Friday, 03 November 2023.



Stage 2 -

- The list of shortlisted teams will be shared by Monday,
 November 2023 on the discord server.
- The AV submitted in stage 1 will be used for promotional activities.
- The Final showcasing will be on Wednesday, 08
 November 2023 in the host school.
- Shortlisted participants will be given an opportunity to pitch their project in front of the judges in the form of a PowerPoint Presentation. The Presentation must contain the headers from the Proposal Template. It must be submitted by Friday, 03 November 2023 through the submission link on Discord
- Each team will be given a total of 7 minutes to present and demonstrate their project and 3 minutes for the Q&A round.

Guidelines for Ground Zero and Mud Race:

- In Ground Zero, teams have to build a manually controlled car that can do simple tasks to follow the given path and put the blocks in target zones so that it can complete the route by overcoming the hurdles in its path.
- In Mud Race, teams have to build a manually controlled car that can do simple tasks to follow the given path.
- The dimensions of the car should be less than or equal to 300mm x 300mm x 300mm (LxBxH) failing which the team will be disqualified from the competition.
- Participants are not supposed to use any readymade kits.
- Individual event guidelines and arena will be sent after the registration.
- Participants need to pitch their cars in front of the judges explaining the features and components used in a form of presentation with the maximum duration not exceeding 5 minutes.
