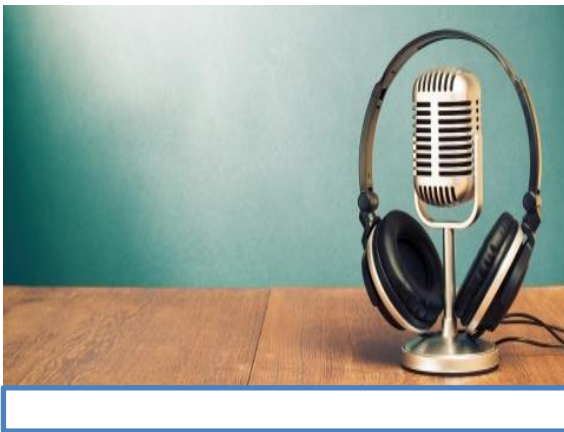
GUIDELINES

Activity 5. Interactive Budgeting Activity:



Imagine yourself to be any one of the merchants planning a new journey. Fix an amount using any 'currency' to spend on various items like food, transportation, goods for trading etc.

- a) Choose how much to spend on each category, keeping in mind the need to save money for unexpected expenses, just like in the tale.
- b) Prepare a list of items with prices and let students decide how to allocate their budget.
- c) Calculate total expenses and compare them with their initial amount you had predicted for the budget. They will adjust their expenditure list to ensure they do not exceed the budget.
- d) Create a visual presentation of their budgeting plan on and outcome, which they can share with the class on an A4 sheet.

Activity 6: Savings Diary

Let's all save this vacation and keep a track of our savings.

Write your daily savings in terms of activities like switching off the electricity when not in use or turning off the water taps and saving water. Give yourself 50 points on each saving and calculate your total points at the end of the day.


Read the newspaper everyday.
