English

Title: "Money Monsters: Learn to Save"

Objective: To explore the principles of financial literacy through the lens of the Tale "Money Monsters: Learn to Save."

Instructions:

Activity 1: Creative Comic

Create a comic strip based on your favourite scene from "Money Monsters: Learn to Save" by Dave Zeltserman. Read the chosen scene, sketch characters and storyboard key events, design panels, write dialogue, and illustrate the strip. Consider adding color for visual appeal. Review and revise before submission.



OR

Activity 2: Design a Game Board

- Use a poster board or large sheet of paper to create the game board. You can draw a path with spaces for players to move along, similar to a board game like Monopoly.
- Divide the path into sections representing different budgeting categories such as food, entertainment, transportation, savings, and charity. You can also include special spaces for events or scenarios that players will encounter during the game.

Mathematics

Activity 1: "Gifts of Love: Saving for Special Surprises"

- Set a savings goal to buy something special for your loved ones. Examples could include saving for a father's desired shirt or a portable kitchen fan for your mother.
- Explain with the help of a table, how are you going to save the required money for the same.
- Share what you are going to buy for your parents or siblings or anyone in need.

Activity 2. Plan a Trip



Your school plans international trips for students of class VI onwards every year. If you have to join these trips, you will have to start saving now.

- Make a plan for saving money for your trip in consultation with your parents.
- Mention, what will you cut down from your expenditure to save this money.

Gond Folk Art:

Gond painting is a famous folk art of the Gond tribal community of Central India (Madhya Pradesh). It is done to preserve and communicate the culture of the Gond tribal community. Gond tribal art includes folk dances, folk songs, and Gond paintings.

The present-day Gond paintings have evolved from Digna and Bhittichitra. The Gonds paint Digna, a traditional geometric pattern on the walls and floors of the houses. Bhittichitra is painted on the walls of houses, and these paintings include images of animals, plants, and trees. Women use natural colors to paint the walls and floors of their homes. Some examples of Gond Art form are shown below.
