Application Instructions

A list of internships available is also mailed. Students must choose two internships, list them in order of preference in the application form and complete the short essay questions.

- The students must submit their CV / résumé, which should be no longer than 2 pages. It must include
 the student's class IX and Class X Pre Board exams (aggregate and subject- wise), the personal details
 (date of birth, address, contact details) and language proficiency. Students must also list their notable
 involvement in co-curricular activities, achievement and awards.
- For creative internships (designing, film-making, writing), please also submit a sample of your work in png/ mp4 format.
- If a student wishes to do an internship in a field not covered in the list, they must contact Ms Arti Anand (artianand@tagoreint.org) by Wednesday, 01 May 2024 to discuss the alternative possibilities.
- Please note: We will be unable to organize internships with Pilots, the Armed Forces, most MNCs, News channels (due to child labour laws), United Nations agencies (due to internal policies), and high-level Defence Science research organizations.
