**Dear Parents** 

As per CBSE guidelines, each student in Classes VI to VIII is required to study THREE languages. English is the first language and is compulsory for all. Hindi is the second language and is compulsory for Indian students. However, nationals of other countries are exempted from studying Hindi.

The school offers German, French and Sanskrit as options for the third language in Class VI. All students have to opt for any ONE of the three. They have to be certain of their choice as they have to study the same language for the next three years and no change at a later date or class will be possible. A student is required to score a minimum of Grade D in the final assessment of the third language to be eligible to be promoted to the next class.

Since there are limited seats in the German and French sections the students will be allowed to opt for German or French on the basis of their grades in English in Class V. Students will be allotted the third language on the basis of the marks scored in all areas of English in both the terms. Students have to score A1 in all areas of English assessment in the TWO TERMS in Class V. The areas of assessment are given below:

- a. Subject Enrichment
- b. Project Based Assessments
- c. Multiple Assessments
- d. Portfolio
- e. Weekly Tests
- f. Mid Term and End term Examinations.

The final decision, however, will rest with the English language teacher, the Principal as well as the availability of seats.

In Classes IX and X, the school follows the two language formula, as per the guidelines issued by the CBSE. English is compulsory and the second language will be based on the second and the third languages opted in Classes VI-VIII and the availability of seats. Please fill the consent form and submit it to the class teacher by **Thursday, 17 April 2025**.
