Points to Note:

- 1. a) Classes VI to VIII will have Third language- (Sanskrit/ French/ German) examination on Monday, 15 September 2025.
 - b) Class XI will have the Informative Practices examination on Monday, 15 September 2025.
 - c) Class IX will have the Information Technology examination on Monday, 15 September 2025.
 - d) The sixth subject examination for Classes XI & XII will be held on Monday, 15 September 2025.
- 2. The schedule of practical exams for Classes XI & XII will be shared by the class teachers through the class Google Groups.
- 3. The schedule for the preparatory leave is as follows:
 - a) Classes X to XII from Saturday, 13 September 2025 to Thursday, 18 September 2025.
 - b) Classes VI to IX from Tuesday, 16 September 2025 to Thursday, 18 September 2025.
- 4. During examination days, the school timings will be from 8:00 am to 11:30 am. Students will be given 15 minutes of reading time at the beginning of the examination, before attempting to answer the questions.
- 5. School buses will leave the school campus at 11:45 am every day during the Mid-Term Examination. Students who travel on their own can leave at 11:35 am from Gate No.2.
- 6. The question papers will be based on the CBSE pattern. Teachers will be giving practice for the same to the students accordingly.
- 7. During the examination there must be no communication between students in writing, speech or gesture once they enter the examination room. A student who resorts to any kind of malpractice during the examination will be awarded ZERO for that particular subject and debarred from appearing for the rest of the papers. NO request will be entertained for showing any leniency in such cases.
- 8. BRINGING MOBILE PHONES TO SCHOOL DURING THE EXAMINATIONS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED FOR ALL STUDENTS.
- 9. As per the examination guidelines issued by CBSE, possession of any electronic item, written material, books, notes etc. will be considered as an attempt to cheat and will result in strict action being taken against the erring student.
- 10. Students must not write anything on the question paper except for their name and roll number. No rough work or calculations should be done on the question paper. Any violation of this rule will be viewed seriously.
- 11. Students must bring their own stationery. They will not be allowed to borrow any stationery during the examination.
- 12. Students **should not come** to school on the days when they do not have an examination.
- 13. The cafeteria will remain closed during the Mid-Term Examination.

The report cards of Classes VI to XII will be given to the <u>PARENTS ONLY</u> on Saturday, 18 October 2025 between 8:30 am and 12:00 noon.
