Dear Parents

As a part of our effort to foster global citizens with a liberal outlook on the world, our school has frequently conducted student exchange programmes with schools in Germany, which are well appreciated by the parents and students alike. These programmes are a rich learning experience for our students. This time as well, we are organising an Educational and Cultural Exchange programme with our partner school **Johannes-Kepler-Gymnasium at Weil der Stadt, Germany from Saturday, 1st November 2025 to Saturday, 8th November 2025.**

This programme includes interaction with the students of the host school at Weil der Stadt, a visit to Heidelberg or Strasbourg, Day Trip to Lake Constance, Visit to the Triberg Waterfalls. The total cost of this programme inclusive of GST is **₹1,70,000/- (Rupees one lakh seventy thousand only)**, which includes :

- Air tickets
- Visa Fees
- All meals (veg & non-veg)
- All accommodation (with host families in Weil der Stadt)
- Entry fees to all monuments and other visits (Black Forest Museum, Maulbronn Monastery - UNESCO World Heritage Site, Mercedes-Benz Museum or Porsche Museum)
- Travel Insurance coverage

Please note that the safety and security of our students will be strictly ensured at all times. The students will be accompanied by our school teachers.

Participation in this exchange programme is completely optional.

If you would like your ward to participate in this programme, kindly submit the consent slip and an initial payment cheque of ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) to the class teacher by Monday, 08 September 2025. The second payment of ₹70,000/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand Only) must be submitted by Friday, 12 September 2025.

DETAILED ITINERARY

1st Day:

- Arrival of students in Weil der Stadt
- Welcome reception at the school
- City tour of Weil der Stadt (birthplace of Johannes Kepler)
- Welcome event at Johannes-Kepler-Gymnasium
- Move-in with host families
- Shared dinner and rest

2nd Day:

- Visit to partner school and interaction with German students
- Visit to Mercedes-Benz Museum or Porsche Museum
- Walk through the Schlossgarten
- Explore Stuttgart city centre (Schlossplatz, Königsstraße, Stiftskirche)
- Return to host families, dinner and rest

3rd Day:

- School visit and cultural exchange activities
- Visit to Maulbronn Monastery (UNESCO World Heritage Site)
- *Alternative:* Visit to Experimenta Heilbronn (interactive science museum)
- Return to host families, dinner and rest

4th Day:

- Travel to Heidelberg/Strasbourg (approx. 1.5 hours)
- Walk across the city
- Free time for exploration
- Return to host families, dinner and rest

5th Day:

- Final visit to partner school for academic and interactive sessions
- Visit to Beuren Open-Air Museum (experience of regional history and culture)
- *Alternative:* Cycling tour or hike in the Swabian Jura
- Return to host families, dinner and rest

6th Day:

- Travel to Meersburg and visit to Meersburg Castle
- Visit to Mainau Island or Zeppelin Museum Friedrichshafen
- Boat trip on Lake Constance
- Return to Weil der Stadt, dinner and rest

7th Day:

- School visit and class participation
- Trip to Baiersbronn or Triberg
- Visit to Triberg Waterfalls and Black Forest Museum
- Souvenir shopping (cuckoo clocks, local specialties)
- Farewell dinner with host families

8th Day:

- Farewell event at the partner school
- Free time for final explorations with host families
- Departure for airport and return flight to India
