1. Important Dates:

- a. The extra classes for Classes X & XII (session 2025-2026) will begin from **Monday, 9 March 2026 till Wednesday, 25 March 2026**. The schedule of classes will be as follows:

Kindly note students will have extra class on Saturday, 14 March 2026 also. Saturday, 21 March will be a Holiday on account of Id-ul-Fitr.

b. The new session **2026-2027** for Classes KG to X and XII will begin on **Wednesday, 01 April, 2026**.

c. Summer vacation schedule for all classes is given below:

The school trip for Classes X & XII is planned from Friday, 29 May to Tuesday, 02 June 2026. Circular regarding the same will be shared in April 2026 through your ward.	

2. School Timings:

- The school timings for classes I to XII are from 08:00 am to 02:00 pm. Students are expected to reach school by 07:50 am. School gates will be closed sharp at 8:05 am.
- No student will be allowed to enter the school after the **school gates close at 08.05 am**. No request with regard to this will be entertained.

3. School Uniform:

The students have to come to school neatly dressed in complete school uniform. After a verbal and written warning in case of the student defaulting, she/he will not be allowed to attend classes.

4. School Almanac:

- You are requested to check the school almanac of your ward every day for any important note sent by the teacher/s.
- Please fill in the required information on the first two pages of the school almanac and submit the first page and the medical record to the **Class Teacher by Saturday, 14 March 2026**.
Kindly read all the rules and regulations of the school as given in the Almanac. You are requested to adhere to them.

5. Communication:

Kindly check the emails on a regular basis. Online classes (whenever planned) can be attended ONLY with the official email id given to you by the school office. This official email id has to be used for all communications.

6. Transport:

- Students using school transport must travel by school bus daily. In case you have to pick up your ward personally, please ensure that a written application is submitted to the school latest by 10:00 am on the day of the pickup.
- Parents using private van services are responsible for verifying that the vehicle is **RTA-registered** and does not operate on **LPG**. Please ensure that both the driver and conductor hold **valid licenses** and have undergone **police verification**.
- Please note that if you intend to discontinue the school bus facility, a two months' notice period is required for the same. **No student will be allowed to withdraw from the school bus facility after September**.
- School Gate No.1 is for bus users** while students using **Van, Personal transport or by self will use Gate No. 2**.

7. Attendance:

- No extended leave after the summer and winter vacation will be granted for any reason.
- The school views absence from classes very strictly**. For any leave of absence, intimation regarding the same should be emailed to the Class teacher and to the school's email id info.eok@tagoreint.com. **Prior permission** from the Principal is mandatory **for more than 3 days of leave**.
- It is imperative for a student to have 75% attendance to be eligible to appear for the End-Term Examination.
- ATTENDANCE IS COMPULSORY FOR WEEKLY TESTS, MID-TERM EXAMINATION, AND PRE-BOARD EXAMINATION AND END TERM EXAMINATION. No student will be allowed to leave school after a weekly test, for any reason. If a student is unwell, she/he should not come to school on that day. No request for a retest will be entertained.
- In case of a medical leave, the medical certificate should be emailed to the class teacher and school office on the same day.

8. Parent's and student's ID-card:

- i. Parents and students must continue to carry the old ID-Card in April and May. New ID-Cards will be issued in July. In case you have misplaced it, you may contact the school for the issuance of a duplicate ID-Card.
- ii. Parents must carry the ID-card issued to them whenever they visit the school.
- iii. At any point in time, students will be handed over only to the person who has been authorised by the parents and whose photograph is affixed on the ID-card.

9. Year Planner:

- i. Each student will receive the **Year Planner** at the start of the new session. It includes details about **activities, assessments, and schedules** for the entire year.
- ii. Parents and students are encouraged to read it thoroughly and refer to it on a regular basis.
- iii. Personal holiday plans should be scheduled as per the school holidays schedule given in the planner to prevent any disruption in learning, ensuring that students make the most of their educational opportunities throughout the session.

10. Fee:

- i. **Online Fee Payment:** Available through the Parent Portal (tiscampuscare.in). The same can also be deposited at AXIS Bank, East of Kailash, New Delhi-110065.
- ii. The fee has to be paid EVERY QUARTER. The fee must be paid by the 10th of the first month of each quarter. Fees can also be paid on a monthly basis and the same should be paid by the 10th of every month. A late fine of ₹20/- per day will be charged after the 10th of the first month of each quarter or after the 10th of the first month of each quarter or after the 10th of the month as applicable.
- iii. If the fee is not paid by the last working day of the month in which they are due, the school will be bound to take action as per the rules laid down in **DSEAR 1973**.

11. Books for Session 2026-2027:

- i. Book sets for Classes X and XII for the session 2026 - 2027 will be available in the school premises as per the following schedule:

- ii. Alternatively, you may purchase the books from any other stationer. The list of books and stationery for the session will be shared through the school website www.tagoreint.com.
- iii. The entry to purchase book sets will be from Gate No 2. Kindly wait patiently for your turn in the queue to avoid crowding near the sale area.
- iv. As a part of our Social Service initiatives, we earnestly appeal to you to donate uniform(s) and old textbooks/storybooks which can be left in the cartons kept near the book sale counters. Kindly ensure that the books and the uniforms are in good condition. Uniforms should not be faded; they should be washed, ironed and packed in brown paper or newspaper. Please leave it neatly labeled with your ward's name, class and your contact number.

13. Please note:

- i. Check the school website www.tagoreint.com regularly for circulars, updates and news about school events. In our drive to go 'zero waste', we are trying to minimize the use of paper used in sending hard copies of circulars home, please check for emails and messages, sent by the school, on a regular basis.
- ii. Parents can meet the Principal/ Headmistress between 09:00 am and 10:00 am on any working day and the teachers on any working Saturday, with a prior appointment. Kindly refer to the year planner for the schedule of working Saturdays.
- iii. The school has an online portal for the benefit of the students and parents. Through this portal, the parents can pay the school fees and check their ward's academic progress.
- iv. It is very important that you inform the class teacher and the school office if there is any change in the residential address, telephone number or mode of transport.
- v. You are also requested to update your email address, in case you have not been receiving any emails from the school. You may send an email to info.eok@tagoreint.com to update your email address.
- vi. **Mobile phones are strictly prohibited for students of Classes Nursery to X.** However, students of classes XI & XII are allowed to carry mobile phones in case they need to travel on their own or need to go for their coaching from school. Kindly send a written request for the same along with the reason to the class teacher at the beginning of the session. **They should keep their mobile phones switched off throughout the school hours including the dispersal time. If any student is found violating this rule, phones will be confiscated and not returned.**
- vii. No student will be allowed to bring steel bottles to the school for any reason.
- viii. We have observed that the students, who come to school on an empty stomach, often report to the school clinic, complaining of dizziness or headache during assembly & otherwise. Kindly ensure children have a nutritious breakfast before coming to school and they also carry their mid-day meal with them.
- ix. **No food packets/lunch box or any other material brought by parents or anyone else will be handed over to the students during school hours.**
- x. The school café facility is also extended to the students. As a step toward stopping the use of plastic, students **must bring an empty tiffin box in case they want to buy food from the cafeteria.** Students are advised not to bring more than ₹50/- to school for the cafe facility. No student will be given any credits by the cafeteria.
- xi. It is indeed a matter of great pleasure to celebrate the birthday of your ward in school. We request you to avoid sending cakes or giving lavish treats to their friends in school. They are allowed to distribute only toffees.
- xii. In conclusion, as a secular institution, we urge you to avoid engaging young minds in discussions centered on religion and politics, as these complex topics may be difficult for them to grasp. Instead, we encourage you to nurture in them a deep respect for all religions and nationalities-reflecting the inclusive and harmonious values we uphold at our school.
