Details of Assessments for Class IX:

- Following assessments will be carried out throughout the session as per the schedule given below:

ASSESSMENT	MARKS	MONTH
Periodic test 1	35 + 35	May – August 2026
Mid Term Examination	80	September 2026
Periodic test 2	35 + 35	Nov 2026 – January 2027
End Term Examination	80	February 2027

- Multiple assessments will be conducted throughout the year
- It is mandatory for students to appear in **each** of the weekly tests, Mid-Term Examination and End-Term Examination.
- Marks of Internal assessment will be added to the Mid-term Examination and End-Term Examination.
- End-Term Examination will be based on the complete syllabus of Class IX.
- If a student misses any test/ examination he/she will be awarded ZERO for the same.
- NO RETEST** will be allowed, under any circumstance, except if the student is representing the school in a co-curricular activity.

Policy for Promotion to Class X :

- In order to be declared as having passed Class IX Examination, a student **must obtain a minimum of 33% marks** in **both** the Internal Assessment **and** the Final Examination and in each of the five subjects individually.
- If a student scores less than 33% in two subjects, it will be considered as compartment, and he/she will have to write the compartment exam and score a minimum of 33% in the same for promotion to Class X.
- If a student scores less than 33% in more than two subjects, he/she will be considered detained in Class IX.
- A printed performance profile will be given after the Mid-term and End-Term Examinations.

Subject & Stream Allocation Criteria for Class XI

The school offers following subjects and streams in Class XI :

English Core is compulsory for all streams. Students opting for Science with Economics or Computer Science will have to compulsorily study Mathematics too. Economics / Psychology will be offered on a first come first served basis at the time of registration, due to limited seats.

The factors deciding the allotment of stream and subjects for class XI will be based on the students' academic performance in the **Mid-Term and Pre-Board Examinations in Class X (Session 2027-2028)** , and their individual preferences. It is imperative that, as parents, you give due importance to your ward's academic performance throughout the year so that she/he qualifies for the stream she/he aspires for. The students are allowed to change their stream after Class X examination results in May 2028, provided they score the grades required for the stream preferred by them.
