Implementation of the New CBSE Three-Language Policy for Class IX

Dear Parents

This is to inform you of an important update regarding the language curriculum for Class IX students for the Academic Session 2026–27.

In alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP), students in Class IX are now required to study three languages, of which at least two must be Indian languages (Bhartiya Bhashas). However as per the **CBSE Press Release dated 29 June 2026**, as a special one-time relaxation, students who have already opted for two non-Indian/foreign languages have been permitted to continue with those languages, provided they take one Bhartiya Bhasha as their third language (R3).

In accordance with these guidelines, the school will implement the R3 language as follows:

- Students currently studying Hindi as their second language (R2) will take Sanskrit as their third language (R3).
- Students currently studying Sanskrit, French, or German as their second language (R2) will take Hindi as their third language (R3).

Please note the following:

- There will be no CBSE Board examination for this third language when this batch appears for Class X in the 2027–28 session.
- The third language (R3) will be assessed internally by the school through school-based evaluations only.
