CIRCULAR

Dear Parents

We hope your ward has now settled into their chosen stream and subjects. Class XI marks the beginning of an important phase of their academic journey, as the subjects chosen will form the foundation for their future higher education and career aspirations. Many colleges and universities in India and abroad consider Class XI marks along with Class XII results during admissions. It is important that students take Class XI academics seriously and work consistently throughout the year.

Kindly note the following important points:

- According to the CBSE Bye-laws, a student must study the subject opted in class XI for two years i.e. in both Class XI & XII. No changes to subjects or streams are permitted by CBSE once the registration process is finalized.
- In case your ward wants to change the subject or stream (subject to availability of the seats in the same), she/he should do so before **Wednesday, 15 July 2026**. After this, NO CHANGE IN SUBJECT OR STREAM WILL BE ENTERTAINED, either in Class XI or later in Class XII. Kindly note this and ensure that your ward works hard in the chosen subjects and stream to avoid the need for a change in the future.
- If your ward wants to opt for a sixth subject, she/he will have to study the subject on her/his own. She/he will have to appear for the **Mid Term and the End Term Examination** and secure a **minimum of 33% marks (separately in theory and practical)** to be eligible to continue with the subject in Class XII.

Promotion policy for class XI

- Students must maintain a **minimum of 75% attendance** during the academic session to be eligible to appear for the End-Term Examination.
- A student must secure **at least 33% marks in each of the five main subjects**, with **33% separately in theory and practical**.
- Passing **English** is mandatory for promotion. Students scoring below 33% in English will be detained in Class XI.
- Students failing in **one subject** will be placed in compartment and must pass the compartment examination, conducted within two weeks of the declaration of results, by securing at least 33% marks.
- Students failing in **two or more subjects** will be detained in Class XI.
- **No conditional promotion, subject change in Class XII, or relaxation in promotion norms will be permitted.**

Admission to foreign university

- Students seeking admission to foreign or private universities may require a **Letter of Recommendation (LOR)** and **Predicted Scores** from the school.
- These will be issued only if the student secures **at least 75% in the final Class XI assessment**.
- Students planning to pursue higher education abroad should also ensure they appear for the **SAT** (for many universities in the USA) and **IELTS or TOEFL** (for many universities in Europe and Australia), as applicable.

You are requested to sign the consent form, mentioning that you have read and understood the promotion policy and send it back to the class teacher by **Wednesday, 15 July 2026**.
